1 THE COURT: How are you?

2 MS. SCHULTZ: I'm doing well, how are you?

3 THE COURT: Good.

4 MS. SCHULTZ: My name is Emily Schultz, I'm
5 (inaudible) DA's Office as a special prosecutor

4 do this before that, we don't have to come back, correct?

5 THE COURT: That is correct.

6 MR. SACCO: Thank you very much.

7 THE COURT: Okay.

8 MS. SCHULTZ: Thank you very much.

9 THE COURT: All right.

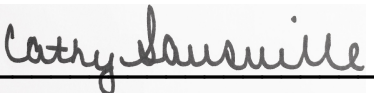
